

# Washington General Election:

Nov 3, 2020

## Voter Registration Deadlines

Online and by mail requests in by Oct 26, 2020

Election day registration (must be in person) Nov 3, 2020

## Deadline to Return Completed Ballot:

Must be deposited in an official drop box by 8pm or post marked by Tue Nov 3, 2020

**All voting is through the mail, but you may turn in your ballot at the Auditors Office before 5pm on Nov 3, 2020.**

### TO QUALIFY TO VOTE IN WASHINGTON

1. Be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Resided in Washington for 30 days prior to the day of election. \*\*
3. Be at least 18 years old.
4. Not be disqualified from voting due to a court order; and not be under Department of Corrections supervision for a Washington felony conviction.

### 3 WAYS TO REGISTER TO VOTE

1. In person at the County Auditors Office located at 135 2nd St. Asotin, WA. Bring picture identification.
2. Print and mail Voter Registration Form to County Auditors Office. (available in multiple languages at [www.sos.wa.gov](http://www.sos.wa.gov))
3. Online at <https://voter.votewa.gov/>  
(Must already have a WA drivers license)

\*\*You do not need a permanent residence to vote in Idaho or Washington. Call your Auditors Office for more info on how to vote without a permanent address or when homeless.

## General Election Day & Last Day to Register to Vote

### TO QUALIFY TO VOTE IN IDAHO

1. Be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Resided in Idaho and in the county for 30 days prior to the day of election. \*\*
3. Be at least 18 years old.
4. Have not been convicted of a felony or have had your rights automatically restored upon completion of sentencing, including probation and parole.

### 3 WAYS TO REGISTER TO VOTE

1. Appear in person at the County Clerk's office located at 1230 Main Street, Lewiston. Bring picture identification.
2. Mail Voter Registration Form to County Clerk. E-mail your request for the form and one will be mailed to you or download the PDF version online.
3. **Election Day registration** is available at your polling place. Bring proof of residence (examples: driver's license, power bill, phone bill, etc.) that shows you have lived at that residence for 30 days and picture identification.

### ABSENTEE BALLOTS

You can either mail in your ballot by Nov 3, or cast in person at your polling place by 5pm the Friday before the election.
